| Commencement | 2. This Order shall come into operation at 6.00 a.m. on Monday, 24 <sup>th</sup> October, 2016. |

| One-way traffic | 3. A person driving a motor vehicle shall proceed in a southerly direction only along the Freeport Access Road, Freeport, between the intersection of the Sir Solomon Hochoy Highway and the northern end of Freeport Access Road and the intersection of Freeport Access Road and Calcutta Road No 1. |

| No Parking   | 4. A person driving a motor Vehicle shall not park on Jerningham Junction Road, Cunupia, between Southern Main Road and Wilson Drive.  |
| Offence and penalty                                  | 5. Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of this Order is liable on summary conviction for a first offence to a fine of seven hundred and fifty dollars and on any subsequent conviction to a fine of one thousand dollars.   |
| Removal and impounding of vehicles unlawfully parked | 6. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parking in contravention of this Order, may be removed by the Police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act. |
