THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC (WINDSCREEN
AND WINDOW TINT) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 2024

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Motor Vehicles and Road
Traffic (Windscreen and Window Tint) (Amendment) Regulations, 2024. Citation

2. In these Regulations, “the Regulations” means the Motor
Vehicles and Road Traffic (Windscreen and Window Tint) Regulations,
2020. Interpretation

3. The Regulations are amended in regulation 6(1)— Regulation 6
amended

(a) in paragraph (b)(vi), by deleting the full stop and substituting
the words “; and”; and

(b) by inserting after paragraph (b), the following paragraph:

“(c) any vehicle, for national security purposes only,
on the recommendation by the Minister with
responsibility for national security, to the Licensing
Authority.”.

4. The Regulations are amended by— Regulation 7
amended

(a) renumbering regulation 7 as regulation 7(1); and

(b) inserting after regulation 7(1), as renumbered, the
following subregulation:

“(2) A certificate under subregulation (1) shall be
submitted to the Licensing Authority within a period
of three months from the date of examination as
specified in the certificate by the medical practitioner,
unless the Licensing Authority grants permission for
the certificate to be submitted after the expiration of
that period.”.
