INCIDENT INVOLVING A TRAFFIC WARDEN

31st January, 2023 MEDIA RELEASE

The Ministry of Works and Transport notes with grave concern the viral video which captured the physical altercation between a Traffic Warden and an off-duty Police Officer of the Trinidad and Tobago Police Service (TTPS) on Monday 30th January, 2023 on Frederick Street, Port of Spain.

Any conduct or the display of behaviour by any member of the public that amounts to interference with the powers of a Traffic Warden and an obstruction in the execution of their duty must be condemned and dealt with in accordance with the law.

Members of the public are reminded that under the *Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act, Chapter 48:50 (MVRTA)*, a Traffic Warden is appointed by the Commissioner of Police, to assist in the control and regulation of road traffic and enforcement of road traffic laws. Also, a Traffic Warden in uniform has the authority to issue Fixed Penalty Notices to motorists for traffic violations.

The Ministry also takes this opportunity to advise the public that section 10A(3) of the MVRTA states: "any driver who fails to comply with the directions given by a Traffic Warden while on duty or obstructs a Traffic Warden in the execution of his duty, or aids or incites any other person not to comply with the directions of a Traffic Warden or to obstruct a Traffic Warden in the execution of his duty, is guilty of an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of **ten thousand dollars and imprisonment for six months**".

The Ministry remains committed to building strong partnerships and working closely with the TTPS in its continuous pursuit to ensure compliance with road traffic laws and promote road safety for all road users.

The Ministry awaits the outcome of the investigation into this matter.
