

PROCUREMENT TENDER NOTICE

Tenderers are invited to submit packages for the Highways Division, Ministry of Works and Transport as follows:

- Project 1 Caroni-Traffic Management Programme (TMP) Phase III-MIR I, Contract Package No.14, Uriah Butler Highway (Caroni), the Supply and
  Installation of AASHTO Type Metal Beam Guardrails along the Uriah Butler Highway Northbound and Southbound lanes, between Caroni Bridge,
  3.791km, to Chaguanas Overpass, 15.586km.
- **Project 2** Caroni- Traffic Management Programme (TMP) Phase III- MIR 3, Contract Package No. 15, Sir Solomon Hochoy Highway (Caroni), Supply and Installation of AASHTO Type Metal Beam Guardrails along Solomon Hochoy Highway Northbound and Southbound.
- Project 3 Victoria West- Traffic Management Programme (TMP) Phase III- MIR 1, Contract Package No. 16, Sir Solomon Hochoy Highway (Victoria West), Supply and Installation of AASHTO Type Metal Beam Guardrails along Solomon Hochoy Highway Northbound and Southbound.

## Separate contracts may be awarded for each project or a combination of projects with no more than two (2) per contractor

The contract will be awarded in accordance with the pre-defined evaluation criteria and scoring system outlined in the Tender Documents. The services to be provided will be governed by the terms and conditions outlined in the respective Tender Documents.

Tender Documents must be accompanied by the following:

- Valid Income Tax and Value Added Tax Clearance Certificates issued by the Board of Inland Revenue and dated not more than six (6) months prior to the closing date of the tender. (Applicable to local firms only).
- A Valid Certificate of Compliance issued in accordance with the National Insurance Act. (Applicable to local firms only).

It is to be noted that failure to include the aforementioned statutory documents, shall result in tender submissions being deemed as invalid and the MOWT shall not proceed with the evaluation of your tender submission having not met this requirement. Tender Bids will beaccepted only from Contractors registered on the **Office of the Procurement Regulation (OPR), Procurement Depository.** 

The original and one (1) copy of the Tender Document should be placed in one sealed envelope addressed to the Procurement Manager/Named Procurement Officer, Ministry of Works and Transport and clearly labelled on the outside:

"Victoria West-Traffic Management Programme (TMP) Phase III- MIR 1, Contract Package No. 16, Sir Solomon Hochoy Highway (Victoria West), Supply and Installation of AASHTO Type Metal Beam Guardrails along Solomon Hochoy Highway Northbound and Southbound" for the Highways Division, Ministry of Works and Transport"

Envelopes must be deposited in the **WHITE Tenders Box no later than 1pm on Tuesday October 17th, 2023** located on the Ground Floor of the Ministry of Works and Transport Head Office, 2-4 London Street, Port of Spain, 100623.

Tenders will be opened shortly thereafter at the Ministry's Head Office. Late tenders will not be considered in any circumstances.
