Proposals must be accompanied by the following:

- Valid Income Tax and Value Added Tax Clearance Certificates issued by the Board of Inland Revenue and dated not more than six (6) months prior to the closing date of the Tender;
- A Valid Certificate of Compliance issued by the National Insurance Board of Trinidad and Tobago in accordance with the **National Insurance Act, Chap. 32:01.**

It is to be noted that Proposals will only be accepted from Suppliers registered on the **Office of Procurement Regulation (OPR) Procurement Depository**.

Sealed submissions comprising one (1) ORIGINAL and four (4) COPIES will be accepted no later than 1:00 p.m. on Monday 31st July, 2023.
